From the Superintendent's Desk

The summer is always a busy time as we prepare our buildings for the next school year, but 2011 will be especially busy as the district completes the construction of the new high school, continues work on the classroom addition at East Elementary, and reconfigures all of our 4 buildings in preparation for the beginning of the school year in August of 2011.

Remember that the new grade configuration, part of the long range facilities plan developed 4 years ago, realigns the grades in all of our buildings. West Elementary will house Preschoolers, 1st grade, and 2nd grade; East Elementary will house 3rd grade, 4th grade, and 5th grade; the current 7-12 building will become a 6th grade, 7th grade, and 8th grade middle school; while the 9th grade, 10th grade, 11th grade and 12th grade will move to the new high school.

With the completion of construction and the shift in grade alignment, all of our buildings will have classrooms to grow into. This will accommodate student growth in the district for a number of years. Ballard anticipates continued and steady growth into the foreseeable future. The district has grown between 7 and 60 students each year for the past 9 years and growth between 20 and 50 students per year is projected.

Although change can be difficult, it presents far more opportunities than challenges. With the help and understanding of staff, students, parents, and district patrons, Ballard will start the new school year at the dawn of a new era. We thank you again for your loyal and constant support as we strive, with you, to educate the whole child and empower all learners.

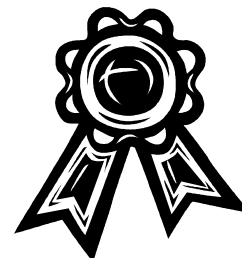

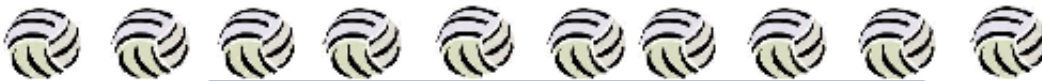
